The 2021 HPRR is located at the Red, White & Blue Range near Cairo, NE.

The High Plains Regional Rendezvous is a pre-1840 Rendezvous. All camps, accoutrements, clothing and trade goods are required to be representative of those prior to the 1840 Fur Trade Era.

LOADING AND UNLOADING AFTER 8:00 A.M. JUNE 21 UNTIL AFTER CLOSING CEREMONIES JUNE 26 IS LIMITED TO 90 MINUTES.

Rendezvous participants must wear primitive clothing to enter, occupy and leave camp from Opening Ceremonies to after Closing Ceremonies. This includes proper footwear for participants of all ages.

Trade Tokens will be awarded for Rendezvous events. All 2021 HPRR tokens must be redeemed at the 2021 Rendezvous.

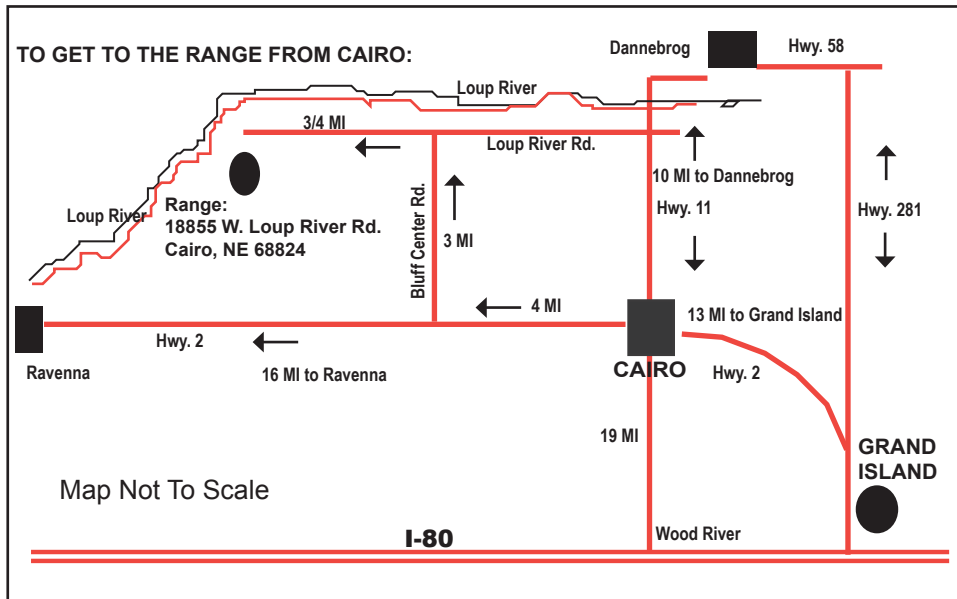
